


Exhibit 3.2.1: Home Early Literacy and Numeracy Activities Before Primary School – Parents' Reports

About the Scale

Students were scored according to their parents' reports regarding the frequency they or someone in the home engaged their children in the sixteen activities on the *Early Literacy and Numeracy Activities* scale. Cut scores divide the scale into three categories. Students who **Very Often** engaged in early literacy and numeracy activities before primary school had a score at or above the cut score corresponding to their parents reporting they "often" did twelve of the sixteen activities and "sometimes" did the other four, on average. Students who **Sometimes** engaged in early literacy and numeracy activities before primary school had a score at or below the cut score corresponding to their parents reporting they "never or almost never" did one of the sixteen activities, "sometimes" did twelve of the sixteen activities and "often" did the other three, on average. All other students **Often** engaged in early literacy and numeracy activities.
